CHAPTER SECRETARY'S OUTLINE OF PROCEDURE

DUAL MEMBERSHIP IN MICHIGAN

I. <u>IF ONE OF YOUR MEMBERS IS OBTAINING A DUAL MEMBERSHIP IN ANOTHER CHAPTER</u> IN MICHIGAN:

- (a) You will receive a request for a Certificate of Good Standing, use Form No. 41.
- (b) NOTE: After your member has been elected to dual membership in the other Chapter, he or she remains a <u>PRIMARY MEMBER</u> and is <u>NOT A DUAL MEMBER IN YOUR CHAPTER</u>.
- (c) NOTE: When annual dues are paid, you give your member a regular dues card. The Secretary of the Chapter where member has become a Dual Member will issue a dues card with a D.M. by the No.

II. <u>IF A MEMBER FROM ANOTHER CHAPTER IN MICHIGAN PETITIONS TO BECOME A DUAL MEMBER OF YOUR CHAPTER:</u>

(a) Eligibility:

Any member in good standing.

(b) <u>Election to Dual Membership:</u>

- 1. Form No. 40 (Petition for Dual Membership), signed by the petitioner and two members of your Chapter, is submitted to you, together with Form No. 41 (Certificate of Membership) signed by the Secretary of the petitioner's Chapter. (An affiliation fee is not required unless so provided in your By-Laws.) You must report this dual member as a new affiliated member on the Annual Return and pay the \$5.00 International Headquarters Fee at that time.
- 2. It then takes the same course as does a Petition for the Degrees.
- 3. Use Form No. 42 to notify the Dual Member of election.
- 4. The By-Laws must be signed within 90 days.
- 5. When signed, notify the Secretary of the primary Chapter on Form No. 43.
- 6. This person is now a <u>DUAL MEMBER OF YOUR CHAPTER AND IS GIVEN A</u>
 <u>DUES CARD WITH D.M.</u> added by the number. (Same dues card as is issued to your regular members.)

(c) Dues Cards thereafter:

1. Do not give the official dues card to a Dual Member until you have requested and received a letter from the other Chapter that he or she is in good standing there, or you have physically seen the dues card issued by the primary chapter for that year.

(d) Demits:

1. A Demit <u>cannot be issued for a Dual Member</u>. Instead, he or she must terminate Dual Membership. (see Law Book, Dual Members, Page 53, number 6)

(e) <u>Termination of Dual Membership:</u>

- 1. Dual Member makes written request that is presented at a regular meeting. If all dues are paid and no charges are pending, the Worthy Matron declares the request granted.
- 2. You enter the action in the Minutes and remove the name of the Dual Member from the Roll.
- 3. You then notify the Dual Member and the Secretary of the Primary Chapter, on Form No. 44.

(f) <u>If Dual Member wishes to sever Dual Membership and become an affiliated member of your Chapter:</u>

- 1. At a regular meeting, present the Petition of Dual Member for Affiliation (Form No. 45) and Demit from the other Chapter.
- 2. If the petitioner is not indebted to the Chapter and no charges are pending, the Worthy Matron declares the Dual Membership terminated and the petitioner an affiliated member of the Chapter. (There is no affiliation fee or balloting on such request.)
- 3. Notify the petitioner of such election on Form No. 46. (The By-Laws need not be signed again.)

(g) Suspension, Withdrawal, Expulsion and Restoration:

- 1. Process these in the same manner for Dual Members as you do for affiliated members; HOWEVER, in the case of Restorations, the applicant must present evidence that he or she is in good standing at that time in the **primary** Chapter.
- 2. Loss of membership in the **primary** Chapter by Suspension, Withdrawal or Expulsion constitutes loss of Dual Membership in your Chapter.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1. A member of a Michigan Chapter may be a Dual Member of another Michigan Chapter.
- 2. A Dual Member pays the same amount of dues as does an affiliated member of the Chapter, with the exception of those whose dues have been remitted by a Michigan Chapter, and regularly elected Life Members of a Michigan Chapter.
- 3. The same Per Capita, International Headquarters Fund \$5.00 Fee, General Grand Chapter \$2.00 assessment and Every Member Project donation is paid to Grand Chapter for a Dual Member as is paid for an affiliated member, with the exception that Per Capita is not paid on those whose dues have been remitted by a Michigan Chapter, or regularly elected Life Members of a Michigan Chapter.
- 4. A Dual Member may vote and hold office, the same as an affiliated member of the Chapter.

CHAPTER SECRETARY'S OUTLINE OF PROCEDURE

DUAL MEMBERSHIP OUT-OF-STATE

I. IF ONE OF YOUR MEMBERS IS OBTAINING A DUAL MEMBERSHIP IN ANOTHER STATE:

- (a) You will receive a request for a Certificate of Good Standing. Many States have forms for this and they are self-explanatory. However, if one is not sent to you, then send a letter under seal stating:
 - 1. That our Law permits Dual Membership.
 - 2. That your member is in good standing, is under no financial obligation to the Chapter and that no other charge is pending (or is not in good standing, as the case may be).
- (b) NOTE: After your member has been elected to Dual Membership in the other Chapter, he or she remains a <u>PRIMARY MEMBER</u> and is <u>NOT A DUAL MEMBER IN YOUR CHAPTER</u>.
- (c) NOTE: When annual dues are paid, you give your member the REGULAR MICHIGAN DUES RECEIPT.

II. <u>IF A MEMBER FROM ANOTHER STATE PETITIONS TO BECOME A DUAL MEMBER OF YOUR CHAPTER:</u>

(a) <u>Election to Dual Membership:</u>

- 1. Form No. 40 (Petition for Dual Membership), signed by the petitioner and two members of your Chapter, is submitted to you, together with Form No. 41 (Certificate of Membership) signed by the Secretary of the petitioner's Chapter. You must supply the petitioner's Chapter with Form No. 41, this is a Michigan form. (An affiliation fee is not required unless so provided in your By-Laws.)
- 2. Send the Petition (Form 40) and Certificate (Form 41) to the Grand Secretary of Michigan for checking and approval.
- 3. After receiving such approval and return to you of the Petition and Certificate, present the Petition at a regular meeting of your Chapter.
- 4. It then takes the same course as does a Petition for the Degrees.
- 5. Use Form No. 42 to notify the Dual Member of election.
- 6. The By-Laws must be signed within 90 days.
- 7. When signed, notify the Secretary of the primary Chapter on Form No. 43.
- 8. NOTE: This person is now a <u>DUAL MEMBER OF YOUR CHAPTER</u>

(b) <u>Dues Cards thereafter:</u>

1. Do not give the dues card to a Dual Member until you have requested and received a letter from the other Chapter that he or she is in good standing there, or you have physically seen the dues card issued by the primary chapter for that year.

(c) Demits:

1. A Demit cannot be issued for a Dual Member. Instead, he or she must terminate Dual Membership. (see Law Book, Dual Members, Page 53, number 6)

(d) <u>Termination of Dual Membership:</u>

- 1. Dual Member makes written request that is presented at a regular meeting. IF all dues are paid and there are not charges pending, the Worthy Matron declares the request granted.
- 2. You enter the action in the Minutes and remove the name of the Dual Member from the Roll.
- 3. You then notify the Dual Member on form No. 44.

(e) <u>If Dual Member wishes to sever Dual Membership and become an affiliated Member of your Chapter:</u>

- 1. At a regular meeting, present the Petition of Dual Member for Affiliation (Form No. 45) and Demit from the other Chapter.
- 2. If the petitioner is not indebted to the Chapter and no charges are pending, the Worthy Matron declares the Dual Membership terminated and the petitioner an affiliated member of the Chapter. (There is no affiliation fee or balloting on such request.)
- 3. Notify the petitioner of such election on Form No. 46. (The By-Laws need not be signed again.)

(f) Suspension, withdrawal, expulsion and restoration:

- 1. Process these in the same manner for Dual Members as you do for affiliated members; HOWEVER, in the case of restorations, the applicant must present evidence that he or she is in good standing at that time in the **primary** Chapter.
- 2. Loss of membership in the **primary** Chapter by suspension, withdrawal or expulsion constitutes loss of dual membership in your Chapter.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1. A member in another State can be a Dual Member in a Michigan Chapter <u>ONLY IF THAT GRAND</u> <u>JURISDICTION PERMITS DUAL MEMBERSHIP ALSO.</u> (See Section 7a, pages 53-54 of the Law Book.)
- 2. It is not necessary to establish six months residence in the State of Michigan before petitioning for Dual Membership.
- 3. A Dual Member pays the same amount of dues as does an affiliated member of the Chapter.
- 4. The same Per Capita, International Headquarters Fund \$5.00 fee, General Grand Chapter \$2.00 assessment and Every Member Project donation is paid to Grand Chapter for a Dual Member as is paid for an affiliated member.
- 5. A Dual Member may vote and hold office the same as an affiliated member of the Chapter.
